

Extra Credit: Canciones en Español

 - Some songs (like "Tengo tu Love") have a few words in English in it, but it needs to be almost all in Spanish.
 - It also should NOT be one of the songs we have used in class, though you can use other songs by the same artist
3. Listen to the song and see what words you can understand. Some songs have English versions that you can listen to. You can also look up the lyrics online.
